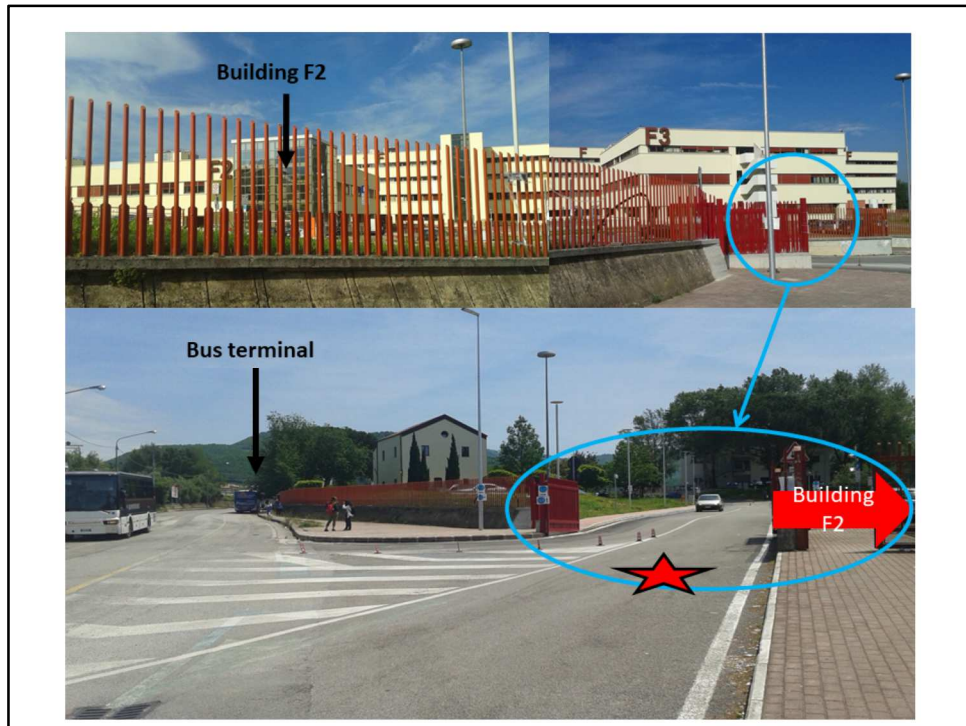


If you arrive to the bus terminal with a bus from Salerno, you have to take two different directions. Follow the blue arrow to go to building F2, the orange arrow to go to Aula Magna.



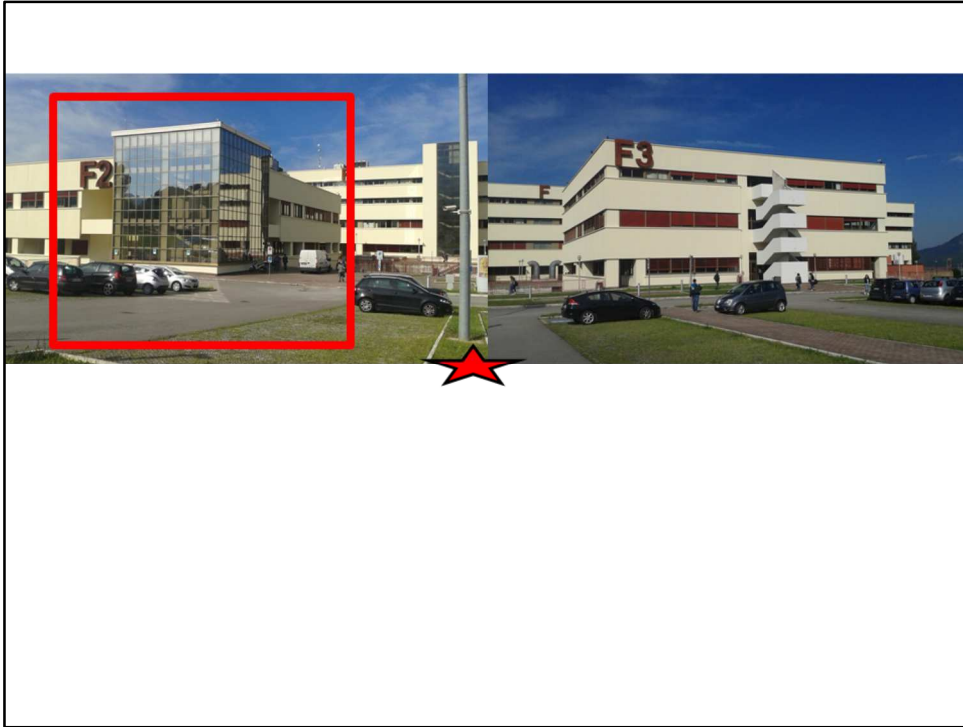
This is the view of the bus terminal. To go towards Building F2, once you are here walk down on the sidewalk **outside the campus** keeping the red railing on your left for approx. 300 m until you will find a big driveway gate to enter the campus (see next)



At the end of the red railing you will find on your left a driveway gate (corresponding to the red star on the map in figure 1) and a small pedestrian gate. You will see three big buildings in pale yellow on your left. The one on the left with a big glass window is Building F2.

If you want to come with car, please note that the circulation in the Campus of Fisciano is forbidden for cars not belonging to UniSA employees. It is however possible to reach a parking area (Park 2 in the campus map) near the buildings F, F2 and F3 where parking is free.

To reach that park area, enter in the gate and leave on your right the first small parking area in front of buildings F, F2 and F3 (forbidden to cars not belonging to UniSa personnel). Follow the road until you reach the free parking area. Park your car and return towards the pale yellow buildings following the road.



View of the buildings in front of the gate marked with the star in the campus map. Building F2 is visible on the left. The park area in front of the buildings is for UniSA employees only.



The entrance to building F2 is just after the big glass window. Cross the left side of the parking area in front of you to go to the building F2 (you should see the road sign “Piazza Renato Caccioppoli”). Go straight on through the entrance at floor 0 and you will find room F2 on your left.



To reach the Aula Magna from the bus terminal (approx. 10' walk), enter in the campus crossing the fence and find the way near a building with yellow railing. Turn right and go down along that way (via Francesco de Sanctis).



You will find this road (via Francesco De Sanctis) with a blue building in front of you.
Walk down along the road towards the blue building



Once arrived at the end of the road, go on the left (via G. M. Galanti) and walk keeping the blue building on your right



Go down towards building D1...



You will have to pass below this bridge between buildings D1 and D in Piazza Pomponio Leto. Continue straight on.



After the bridge, you will find a square (Piazza del Sapere) with this fountain on the right, in front of building D2. Go straight on keeping this fountain on your right



When you will arrive in this square (Piazza del Sapere), the Aula Magna is in front of you.
Continue walking straight on



and you will find the Aula Magna building in front of you. To reach the entrance, go ahead and keep the right...



This is the entrance of Aula Magna. From the bus terminal it takes less than 10 minutes walk to reach it.



If you want to park your car in the multifloor park (Park 1, shown in the picture) and walk to Aula Magna, once left the car, exit from the multifloor park and keep it on your right...

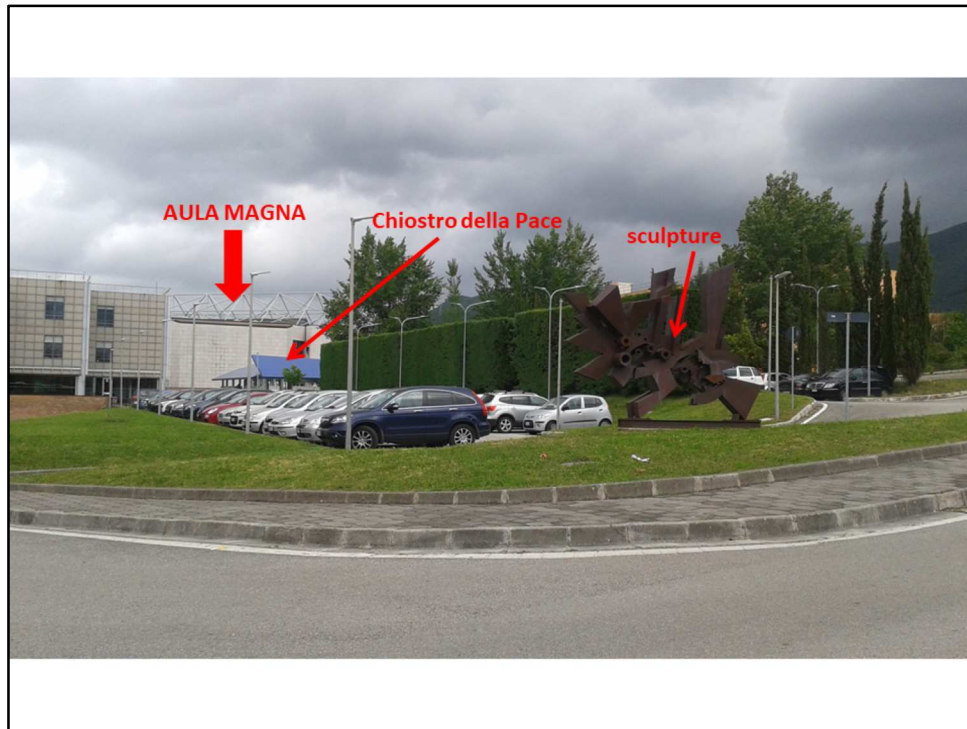
until you will find this red gate for pedestrians on the left. Cross the road (viale Giovan Battista Vico) and enter in the campus through the small pedestrian gate



Once you have passed the gate, you will find this strange sculpture on your left. Turn right and walk along the road



You will find a park (reserved to UniSA employees) on the left. You can start seeing the Aula Magna building in front of you.



Cross the road and go ahead towards Aula Magna. You will see another strange iron sculpture on your right. Walk towards Aula Magna crossing the park area



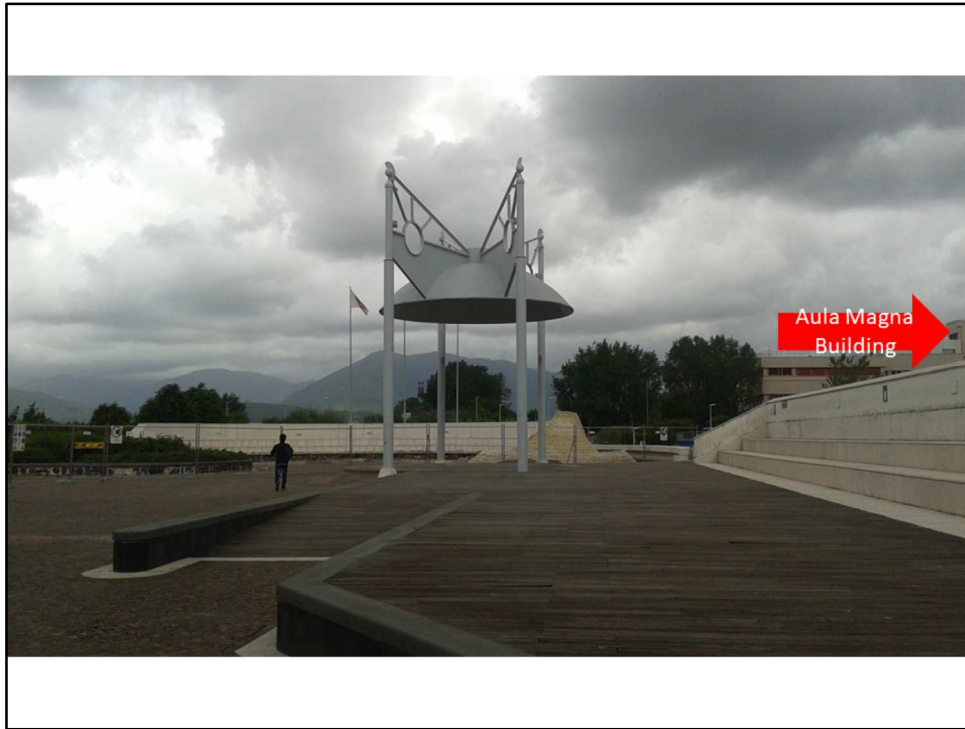
Go ahead. Aula Magna is in front of you



Go ahead keeping this building with blue roof (Chiostro della Pace) on your right.



You'll have to go under this gangway



and you will arrive in this square (Piazza Gabriele de Rosa). The Aula Magna building is on your right



This is the entrance of Aula Magna. From the multifloor park it takes less than 10 minutes walk to reach it.
